Mikael Franson finished half a second behind Andy in 5th place.

A Final Leg Two

Another clean start to the final saw David Spashett in 1st followed by Andy Griffiths, Markus Mobers and Mikael Fransson. These 4 drivers were all very close and after a minute they were starting to pull away from the rest of the field. By 5 minutes Andy, Markus and David had pulled away from Mikael and it looked as though there was going to be another close finish. The order remained the same until the start of the last lap when a back marker blocked Andy as he tried to lap him. This bad driving let David through into the lead. He only had the rest of the lap left to hold on to the lead. He managed do this to become the 1998 European Champion by winning the first two
