


The Daehwa radio control system is described **by DAVE PEARSON**

Dae Hwa electronics of Korea have just introduced the DH-2T 27R onto the U.K. market, now, before you start to think, not another 27MHz two function radio outfit, take a little time and look a little closer at this one. There are some features of this outfit that make it stand out from the crowd, the transmitter is cased in grey plastic that is neatly and cleanly moulded. Both control sticks are enclosed in a black plastic panelled area, which contrasts well with the grey and gives a very attractive,

professional look to the outfit. Equipment level on the DH-2T 27R is high, a large, easy to ready battery level indicator is mounted above the recessed on/off switch, both are placed between the control sticks. Each stick has its own trim switch, the left hand or throttle stick also has a two position neutral and is easily switched between the two. Crystal changing on the DH-2T 27R is easy as the crystal is held in its own mount, and plugged directly into the front of the case, the transmitter is equipped with its own charging jack should a nicad pack be in use. The last and most interesting feature is on the bottom of the transmitter case, deeply recessed to avoid accidental switching are the servo reversing switches, a function that once experienced is hard to live without.

Receiver

The Daehwa receiver is robustly cased and measures 21/8 x 11/2 x 3/4in. so although not in the micro league is quite compact. Each of the two function channels and the power channel is clearly marked, so that even a raw beginner can have no problems deciding what goes where.

Servos

Two servos are supplied with the outfit and again appear to be of very high quality indeed, although no figures are quoted in the instruction manual, the servos seem to be smoth and powerful in operation. The servo cases are in three parts, firmly held

together by four screws, a rubber 'O' ring seals all very effectively.

In conclusion, the Daehwa radio control system gives good value and is very competitively priced, any potential purchaser is rewarded with a quality outfit, offering some outstanding features such as the servo reversing facility, these days with on board space at a premium this must be a plus point. For the more technically minded a full specification is listed below.

Transmitter: Size 7 x 7 x 21/4in. Weight: without battery 15ozs. Battery: Eight AA per cells dry or nickel cadmium.

Receiver: Size: 21/8 x 11/2 x 3/4 in. Power: Supply four dry or nickel cadmium per cells. Receiver type: Superheterodyne double tuned front end. IF Frequency: 455 KHz. Weight: 1oz. Antenna length: 38in.
