The Noisy End

With the Cosmo being designed in two wheel drive guise, all of the important engineering is contained at the rear.

Suspension is via swinging arm with damping contained by identical shock absorbers to those at the front.

The gearbox comprises a centrally split housing, containing the now conventional nylon bevel differential. This gearbox can be ball raced at a later date, as and when the kit supplied nylon bushes become

In order for the beginner to acclimatize themselves with the cars handling, Kyosho have taken the idea of the centrifugal clutch from 1/8 scale I.C. cars and introduced it into the drive system of the Cosmo.

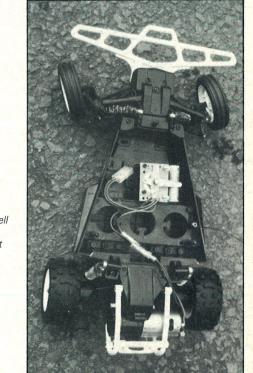
The normal motor pinion is replaced by a pinion with an aluminium bell housing attached. A steel shaft passes through the centre of the clutch and is attached to an alloy end plate. Into the end plate is screwed three small machine screws, acting as pivots for the three section nylon shoes.

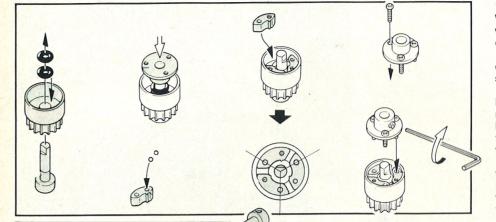
Upon application of power to the motor, the clutch shoes will open centrifugally and engage upon the bell housing, giving very progressive acceleration, especially

when driving an loose ground. This new system of drive should give easier handling, longer running time and help prolong the effective life of the motor. With the gearbox attached to the main chassis, the rear of the car is completed by fitting a nylon cage to protect the motor from damage

Giant dogbones complete with vanes instead of pins are used. This stops them parting company with the car in the event of a crash.

erate unit, prior to being offered up to the rest of the car and comprises lower wishbones, with upper links. The pivot points on both parts being produced as part of the moulding, offering strength and simplicity for long life. Ball joint pivots, which screw into the steering arms, are neatly held captive with a thin metal plate and three screws, when fitted into both top and bottom suspension arms. Unlike the cheaper Kyosho Pegasus kit, which preceded the Cosmo, proper coil over oil filled shock absorbers are supplied with gold anodised shock body, chrome plated springs and red moulded nylon cups and spring tension adjusters, the shock absorbers add greatly to the cars aesthetic appeal, especially to youngsters looking for something to impress their friends with.
